

House Rules LatinVillage Festival

- Bring a good mood!
- The minimum age for the festival is 18. Entry will be denied to anyone under 18. ID is required!
- All visitors will be searched upon entry. Entry is only granted after a security check.
- The organization reserves the right to deny or revoke access without the right to a ticket refund.
- Earplugs are available at the First Aid station.
- LatinVillage Festival operates a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy. If any prohibited substances (hard or soft drugs) are found on a visitor, the substances will be confiscated, and entry will be denied. This applies even to small amounts within decriminalization guidelines. Visitors found with larger quantities will be handed over to the police or judiciary.
- The use and sale of nitrous oxide (N₂O) is prohibited on and near the festival grounds.
- (Fire/stabbing) weapons and sharp or dangerous objects are strictly prohibited. Any object that can be used as a weapon will be confiscated.
- Fireworks are prohibited!
- Bringing your own food or drinks is not allowed.
- Items containing propellants (e.g., aerosol deodorants or perfume bottles) are not allowed on the festival grounds.
- LatinVillage Festival is for everyone, so be respectful. Aggression and racism will not be tolerated.
- Group expressions of any kind are prohibited.
- Always follow instructions from staff, security, and emergency services.
- Umbrellas are not allowed on the festival grounds.
- Selfie sticks are not allowed on the festival grounds.
- Bringing professional photo/film/video/audio equipment is not permitted. Regular digital cameras and phones are allowed.
- Wearing Dutch football jerseys or similar items is not allowed.
- Visitors may not walk around shirtless or with a bare torso.
- Portrait rights apply during the festival. This means filming, photography, and audio recordings may take place. These images and/or recordings may be used by the organization for promotional or publication purposes.
- Attending LatinVillage Festival is entirely at your own risk.
- Once you leave the festival grounds, re-entry on the same day is not allowed without a valid ticket.
- The organization reserves the right to deny anyone access to the festival at 2any time.
- The organization reserves the right to change the festival policy at any time.
- Animals, alcohol, bottles, cans, and glass are not allowed on the festival grounds.
- Commercial activities on or around the festival grounds are prohibited.
- The organization reserves the right to change the date, times, program, and/or location of the festival.
- The organization is not responsible for any damage to visitors' property.
- Visitors who misbehave in any way on or around the festival site will be immediately removed from the premises.
- The organization may implement additional safety measures. These must be followed at all times.
- It is prohibited to possess or operate unmanned aerial vehicles (drones) on the festival grounds.
- Smoking is not allowed inside tents or covered areas.
